## KAZOO!

#### What you need:

- 3 elastic bands
- 2 lollipop sticks
- Straw cut into two smaller pieces (2cm bits)
- 2 mini elastics/loom bands



- L Put elastic band over 1 lollipop stick lengthways.
- 2. Put 1 piece of straw under the elastic band.
- 3 Put the other piece of straw at the other end this time on top of the elastic band.
- Place the 2nd lollipop stick on top like a sandwich!
- Use the 2 mini elastic bands or loom bands to secure the two ends 1 piece of straw will be on top of the elastic band and 1 piece will be under the elastic band.
- 6. When you blow over the elastic band, it vibrates creating sound!
- You can change the frequency by moving the straw piece that is on top of the elastic band up and down the sticks.









## BANJO!

#### What you need:

- Jar lid
- 2 lollipop sticks
- 2 large elastic bands
- 4 mini elastic bands
- Sellotape
- Paint to decorate



- Carefully wrap the elastic bands around the jar lid.
- 2 Secure the bands in place using tape on the back of the jar lid.
- 3. Tape the 2 lollipop sticks together.
- 4. Tape the sticks to the back of the jar lid.
- 5 Paint the lollipop sticks or the jar lid get creative!



# PICNIC MAKERS


## CASTANETS!

#### What you need:

- Small rectangle piece of cardboard
- Glue
- 2 bottle caps
- **Paint**

- 🔓 Fold the piece of cardboard in half.
- Lang glue, attach 1 bottle cap to the cardboard –a few millimetres in from the edge.
- 3. Attach the second bottle cap to the opposite side of the cardboard.
- Paint or decorate the cardboard however you like!
- Clap the cardboard together the two bottle caps make a











## DRUM

#### What you need:

- Balloon
- Scissors
- Coffee Cup/Jar
- Paint



- Carefully cut the top off the balloon.
- 2 Stretch the balloon around the top of the cup or jar.
- You can paint the cup/jar or use stickers or coloured paper. Be as creative as you like!
- You now have your very own drum! Use pencils, paintbrush or anything as drumsticks to make some noise!



## RAIN MAKER

#### What you need:

3 toilet roll tubes/1 kitchen roll tube. 2 cardboard circles, tin foil, scissors, sellotape & beans/rice/lentils



- Attach the toilet roll tubes together one on top of the other.
- Attach 1 cardboard circle to seal up one end of the tube.
- 8 Roll some tinfoil into a long tube or wand shape.
- 4 Squish the tinfoil and shape it into a spiral.
- Carefully place the tin foil into the toilet roll tube.
- S Pour in a handful or half a cup of beans/rice/lentils.
- Attach the other cardboard circle to the end to seal the rain maker.
- Set creative with the outside of the tube you can use paint/markers/coloured card/stickers etc.
